## Schakowsky Statement Against the FISA Amendments Act

- Washington, D.C.--U.S. Representative John Conyers (Schakowsky) today stated the following:
- H.R. 6304 contains an “exigent circumstances” loophole that permits the Administration to conduct warrantless surveillance.
  - Secondly, while H.R. 6304 contains a general prohibition on “reverse” targeting, it lacks the necessary safeguards to ensure that the law is not used to target U.S. citizens.
  - Lastly, the retroactive immunity language in Title II virtually ensures the dismissal of any civil suits brought against the government.

Ultimately, I believe that the President has presented Congress with a
