And while answering a question about White House efforts to find those responsible within the Administration for leaking to the media the identity of an undercover CIA agent, President Bush said, "I'd like to know." □ However, President Bush has refused to ask White House staff to sign affidavits denying their involvement □ in the leak. □ The President has also refused to ask Attorney General Ashcroft to recuse himself since he is closely tied to members of the Bush White House who may be responsible for the leak.
