## Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Cole:

I am requesting funding for the Evanston/Skokie District 65 for fiscal year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Evanston/Skokie District 65, 1500 McDaniel Ave, Evanston, IL 60608.

The funding would be used primarily to fund 20 living stipends for each of the CREATE residents as part of the CREATE program. Starting in school year 2021/2022, CREATE will be placing 20 resident teachers in 3 training academy District 65 schools where they will be paired with a Lead Teacher. Residents will be in classrooms four days a week while taking their Master's level coursework with one of CREATE's university partners. There will be residents trained in bilingual education, special education, STEM, and early childhood. All residents will be trained with a focus on equity, anti-racist practices, and culturally relevant teaching. Upon earning their Master's degree and PEL and meeting the expectations of their student teaching, residents will be offered a teaching position within in the district. To participate in the residency, aspiring teachers make a 4-year commitment to teaching in the district after completing the year-long residency.
