4 This Act may be cited as the "Bumping on Over5 booked Airplanes Requires Dealing Fairly Act" or the
6 "BOARD Fairly Act".

## SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF DENIED BOARDING ON AN AIR CRAFT.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor5 tation shall modify part 250 of title 14, Code of Federal
6 Regulations, to ensure that an air carrier—

7 (1) may not refuse to transport a passenger
8 holding a confirmed reserved space on a flight to
9 provide a seat for another passenger, regardless of
10 whether such passenger is an employee of an air car11 rier;

12 (2) negotiates and solicits a volunteer to relin13 quish his or her space before boarding the aircraft;
14 and

(3) if necessary, continues to increase the
amount of compensation offered until a volunteer
willingly accepts the offer in exchange for relinquishing a confirmed reserved space.

(b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act
restricts the ability of an air carrier to remove a passenger
for safety or security reasons.
