I am requesting funding for the **Pace Bus Touhy Avenue Transit Signal Priority Project** in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Pace Bus, 550 W. Algonquin Road, Arlington Heights, IL 60005. The funding for this project would facilitate implementation of Transit Signal Priority along Pace Bus's Touhy Avenue line.
