I am requesting funding for the Cary Water System Resiliency and PFAS Mitigation Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Cary, 755 Georgetown Dr., Cary, Illinois, 60013. The funding for this project would facilitate the construction of a deep well to mitigate the impact on water access from two wells out of operation due to PFAS levels. Additional improvements to the water system would add interconnections between pressure zones, allowing the Village to pump water throughout the entire distribution system, enhancing pressure, quality, and quantity of water available to all residents. At the same time, this interconnectedness will create necessary redundancies that reduce the likelihood of service disruptions.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is available under Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
